HCAAs and LPNs: Safe Lifts and Transfers

Learn proper techniques to ensure safe patient lifts and transfers to minimize risk of injury.

Code of the Month

PURPLE

Hostage Situation

A **Code Purple** indicates a hostage situation and requires immediate action.

Please follow these safety protocols to ensure everyone's safety:

Upon discovery of a hostage situation:

- Ensure your own safety first. If safe to do so, leave the incident location and find a safe area to call for assistance.
- Activate Code Purple to alert others to the emergency.
- Call 911
- Prevent others from entering the area to avoid further escalation and keep the situation contained.
- Show a calm and reassuring manner to help reduce panic and maintain control.

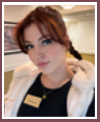
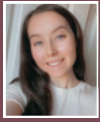
The heating issues have been resolved - thank you for your patience. However, we are still monitoring concerns with domestic hot water circulation following the recent water shutdown.

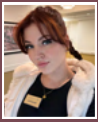
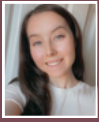

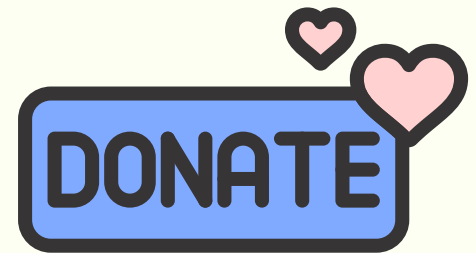
Annual Horticulture Program – Seeking Donations & Volunteers!
